Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

Armistice day coming on the second Tuesday of November, the Board decided to hold its next regular meeting on Monday, Nov, 10, 1941.

The Board decided that hereafter it would pay the schools receiving aid for transportation from the County on a two payment per school year plan. The first payment of one half of the yearly appropriation to be made at the beginning of the school year and the second payment to be made in February of each school year. The Clerk was instructed to pay to the Contractors for each school receiving this aid, at the next meeting, the balance necessary to bring each schools share up to one half of the amount due it for the present school year.

On the certificates of Dr. P. J. Bean and Dr. F. A. Camalier the Board committed Susie Abell to Spring Grove State Hospital, as of Oct, 27, 1941.

The Board considered a request from the Superintendent of Spring Grove State Hospital that they authorize the examination and commitment to the Hospital of Walter Baker and that the County assume responsibility for him. It was claimed that Baker was a former resident of St. Mary's County but was sentenced to the Maryland Penitentiary from Prince George County in 1920 and that he was later transferred to Spring Grove and his sentence has now expired, but he is still insane. The Board instructed the Clerk to write the Superintendent that they refused to accept responsibility for Baker.

The Clerk was instructed to advise the Maryland Council of Defense that Mr. Aloysius F. King had been appointed Director of Civilian Defense for St. Mary's County.
