Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

On the certificates of Dr. A. C. Welch and Dr. Robt. T. Fuchs Board committed Joseph Short to Crownsville State Hospital as of March, 4, 1942.

Miss L. M. Dent, Superintendent of Schools discussed with the Board some possible request for schools in the 1942 levy. She also again requested the County to maintain the drive ways to various schools situated on roads.

Miss Dent also complained about the condition of entrances to Jarboesville H.S., Margaret Brent H.S., Mechanicsville school and River Springs school, due to stepped up culverts or faulty drains. Mr. Thompson asked to look into the condition of these school entrances and to report on the question of maintaining the school drive ways.

Mr. A. F. King, Director, C. D. requested the Board to authorize the purchase of 50 auto whistles to be installed on the Automobiles of Air Raid Wardens as warning devices for air raids. The Board authorized the immediate purchase of 25 whistles and the future purchase of 25 more if it was found advisable to do so. The cost, including installation of each lot of 25 whistles not to exceed \$375.00.

Being a special meeting the minutes were not read.

The Board decided that in view of the possible heavy demand for public funds in case of emergencies it would not provide a fund for operating a public library, at this time.

The Board ordered that \$75.00 be allowed in the 1942 levy for beetle control by the Extension Service.

The Board ordered that voucher # 1 1941 scrip issued to St. Mary's ~~MMS~~ Hospital in the amount of \$837.00 and voucher # 218 1941 scrip issued to ~~Wm. P. Wise, Treas.~~ in the amount of \$1538.50, both of which had been omitted from the 1941 levy, be paid from the balance remaining in the 1941 contingent fund.

The Board decided to provide for a laboratory at St. Mary's Hospital to the extent of : Not exceeding \$550.00 for Equipment, and a reasonable amount for supplies each year, and up to \$450.00 per year as part of the salary of a technician.

The Board accepted the offer of the U.S. Navy Dept. of \$2200.00 for the Public Landing and wharf at Millstone.

The Clerk was instructed to write Mr. Thompson and ask ^{him} to try to get the question of fence posts for Capt. Will Clarke cleared up as soon as possible.

Board adjourned at 3.45 P.M.
