Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

On the advice of the ~~the~~ Attorney the following resolution was offered, seconded and unanimously adopted:

Resolution: That the County will accept one fourth of the County taxes, for the year 1942, on all property taken by the United States of America at Cedar Point, as full settlement for all claims of the County against this property for 1942 taxes; and the County Treasurer is hereby authorized to refund three fourths of the amount paid by any one who may have already paid the Full year's (1942) taxes on any of the above mentioned property.

The Board decided that it had no authority to authorize the acceptance of less than the full years taxes for the State.

Mr Wm. G. Fenwick and Wm. A. Loker, representing the Commissioners of Leonardtown, again appeared before the Board in regard to a portion of the Financial Corporations shares tax which they claim is due Leonardtown. There was general discussion of the ~~matter~~ subject. The Board decided to let the matter stand over until the next meeting.

Clerk was instructed to write the State Roads Commission and recommend the acceptance into the County Road system, for maintenance, the Cora Clarke road, 1st Dist.
