Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.
Dr.L.B.Johnson, President and R.Bascom Broun, Cashier of the 1st National Bank of St.Mary's appeared before the Board in reference to the 1942 valuation of the shares of stock of this Bank by the State Tax Commission for the the shares tax, the valuation of \$.773 for taxing purposes having been protested by this Board. There was considerable discussion of the question of what a fair valuation of this stock for taxing purposes would be. It was finally agreed that \$12.00 per share would be fair valuation for taxing purposes and Dr.Johnson and Mr.Broun agreed to recommend this amount to the Banks Board of Directors for approval.

The Clerk was instructed to write the State Tax Commission and ask It to postpone the hearing on this case, set for the 25th inst. until Oct,5,1942 or as soon thereafter as possible, in order to give the Bank's Directors time to act on the matter.

Major Burgee and Mr.R.Bascom Broun appeared before the Board ~~and~~ in reference to the County Minute Men, with particular reference to the question of equipment for this organization. After discussion of the question of having a body of trained and ~~armed~~ men ready in case of need. They asked the County to provide 100 30.30 Cali. rifles to cost \$2783.00, 5000 30.30 cali. cartridges to cost \$412.50 and 7,500 22cali. cartridges to cost \$45.00, a total of \$3220.50. No action taken by the Board pending a report from It's Attorney as to whether the Board could legally borrow the money for this purpose.

It was stated that a movement was on foot to have the next Legislature provide funds to reimburse the Counties for funds provided by them for equipment for the Minute Men.

Apetition signed by ~~XXXXXXXXXXXX~~ G.H.Stanford, et al, asked the Board to accept into the County road system, for maintenance, about 1/8 of a mile of road leading to St.Patrick's Creek, 7th Dist. Mr.Thompson asked to report.

Mr.Thompson gave favorable verbal reports, on Accepting into the County road system, for maintenance, on the ~~XXXXXXXXXXXX~~ Canoe Neck Creek road extension, about .2 mile, 7th Dist, and the Hopton Park road, 3rd Dist.

The Clerk was instructed to write Mrs Mary S.Hayden to have right-of-way deed executed and recorded for the Canoe Neck Creek road and to Mr.Eddie Nelson to do the same for the Hopton Park road.
