Being a special meeting the minutes were not read.

The board conferred with the War Public Works Authorities on the war needs for a new jail in St. Mary's County, the overwhelming need for which is caused by the great influx of workers on the Cedar Point Naval Air Base and other war activities in the County, the jail, at times being so crowded with prisoner that there is not room for them to sleep on the floor, it being necessary, at times to release prisoners because there is no room to detain them. The question was discussed at some length, and the War Public Works Authorities suggested some changes in the written application for funds for the new jail which had been filed by the Board. Board agreed to make these changes and authorized Mr. Jas. J. Baldwin, Architect to make the necessary changes in the application.

The Board ordered that Mrs Alvey be released from her agreement.

The Clerk was directed to write the State Roads Commission and recommend that the County road workers pay be increased 10 cents per hour, as of Nov, 1, 1942, to correspond to the pay of the State road workers. And also to recommend to the Commission that the McKay's Beach road extension, 2nd District, and the Hopton Park road, 3rd District be accepted into the County road system, for maintenance.
