On motion by Mr Jarboe, seconded by Mr. Guy and declared unanimously carried the Board approved the following proposed laws.



Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

Father Parker, heading a delegation from the 2nd & 8th Districts appeared before the Board and asked that steps be taken to have the Public School Busses transport the Parochial school children to and from Little Flower school, Great Mills, Md. The need for this being, that due to inability to get competent Bus drivers or repairs for the busses, they were unable to operate the Little Flower busses

Miss Dent, Supt of Public schools, being absent from the County the delegation appointed ~~XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX~~ Father Parker, Messrs Thomas Springer and Neal Hayden and Mrs Melvin Jarboe and Mrs Leonard Mayor to represent them at a special meeting to be held at this office Friday Feb, 26, 1943 at 3.00 P.M. when Miss Dent and the Board of Education would be invited to attend with their Attorney, when it would be decided just what could be done to reopen Little Flower school. The Committee was asked to find out just how many of these children would be able to find room on each of the Public School busses at this time.

The Board ordered that the County Commissioners, Justices of Peace, Super of Assessments and attorney to Board be paid quarterly, on the first meeting date after the end of each quarter and that all officials and employees who have been paid monthly should be paid on the first meeting day after the end of month for which they are being paid.
