

Board met at 10.15 A.M.

Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

On the certificates of Dr. F. F. Greenwell and Dr. Eugene C. Peck the Board committed Mary Louise Miedzinski to Rosewood State Training School, as of August, 13, 1943.

Messrs Chas. Hammett, Bernard Goodwin, Aubrey Norris, Jno. Springer and Thos. Springer, representing the Patrons of Little Flower school appeared before the Board and stated that the Little Flower school was not satisfied with the arrangements made with Father Gipprich for each school to transport the children to and from school and the County to provide \$25,000.00 to be divided among them during the coming school year and stated that unless the children were transported by the County the school would not open this year *and the County would be sued*

The Board of Education was invited to attend the meeting and arrived at 4.50 P.M.

The two Board immediately met in joint session.

Mr. Dorsey asked the Board of Education if it would be willing to administer the fund for transportation of children to schools not receiving State aid and contract with the various school Directors to transport these children.

On the objection of Miss L. M. Dent, Supt., Public schools, the Board of Education did not agree to Administer the transportation funds for these schools, after considerable further discussion of the problem the joint meeting adjourned at 6.15 P.M..

The County Commissioners resumed their regular meeting and again consulted Father Gipprich who advised that all the schools interested had agreed to continue to operate their busses and contract with the County to transport the children except the Little Flower school and that in his opinion this school would also accept the plan. The Board agreed to divide \$25,000.00 among these schools to be apportioned among the various schools on the following bus milages: Sacred Heart School, 70 miles; Holy Angels School, 80 miles; St. Mary's Academy, 50 miles; Chaptico, 59 miles; Mechanicsville, 80 miles; St. Joseph's, 122 miles; St. John's, 146 miles; Medley's Neck, 70 miles; St. Michaels, 170 miles; St. Peter Claver, 118 miles; Little Flower, 200 miles; Valley Lee Colored School, 74 miles.

The Clerk was instructed to have contracts and bonds prepared for each school.
