Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

Father Diamond appeared before the Board and stated that he would be ~~xxx~~ unable to sign an agreement to transport the colored children from St. George's Parish, Valley Lee, to St. Peter Claver school; he further stated that he had appointed a committee composed of Ella Thompson, Le Roy Thompson and Emma Green to handle the transportation question, but they had refused to take over the responsibility.

Father Diamond offered to lease the School bus for the nominal sum of one dollar for the 1943-44 school year on the condition that it be returned at the expiration of the school year in as good condition as it was when it was leased. ~~Father~~

The Board authorized Mr. Cecil to make the necessary arrangements about getting a driver for this bus in order that it may continue to operate and transport the colored children of St. George's Parish to St. Peter ~~xxx~~ Claver School. *Father Diamond agreed to operate bus until he could make other arrangements*

On the Certificates of Dr. F.F. Greenwell and Dr. Frank A. Camalier the Board committed Walter Butler to Crownsville State Hospital, as of Sept, 1, 1943.

Mr. W.W. Dunbar appeared before the Board and requested it to accept into the County road system, for maintenance, part of the road from the Wynne State road to Courtney's Marine Railway, about 1/4 mile, 1st Dist. He claimed that 5 families and 14 war workers would be benefitted. Mr Thompson asked to report and to contact Mr. Dunbar.

Mr. T. Harry Drury appeared before the Board and asked it to accept into the County road system, for maintenance, the road running from the State road to Capt. Mat Bailey's place past his farm to St. Catherine's Sound, about 1/2 mile, 7th Dist. Mr. Drury stated that 4 other families and a number of Watermen would be benefitted by this road. Mr. Thompson asked to report and to contact Mr. Drury.
