Mr. Baldwin, architect, explained the plan and specifications for renovation of the old jail to convert to offices. Specifications had to be supplemented as regards stages of payment for completed work.

Mr. Baldwin presented a plan whereby it is thought that may be the Court House can be enlarged with financial assistance under the Federal Agency

It is proposed that

Mr. Jas. Baldwin, arch. proposes that he be authorized to make plans for enlarging and renovating the Court House, at a fee of \$5,000.00- one half to be paid for by the Agency under the George Act- or other agency- the other half to be paid for by the County. Of the \$2,500.00 obligated by the County they are to receive a credit of \$500.00 guaranteeing to Mr. Baldwin \$2,000.00 the Commissioners to do all in their power to collect the balance of his fee from the other agency.

Meeting for the Court House was discussed at length.
