Delegation and petition to oil St. John's Church Road from Leonardtown-Hollywood intersection- distance of about 1½ miles. Board will recommend.

Mrs. Daisy Oleson, Hollywood et al. Request repairs to "Blackistone" section of Clarke's Landing Road.

Mr. Lawrence Henderson and delegation here, re St. George's Island road, erosion. Board conferred with State Roads Commission on this question at Baltimore on July 17th inst. S.R.C. declined to allocate from Road Finds-gasoline tax the amount necessary for project; claiming that the County funds for the current year are exhausted and that the account is overdrawn.

Board decided to have the necessary work done at an expense not to exceed \$10,000.00, provided Mr. Briscoe's advice on the legal phase finds same can be done

Mr. Jos. A. Mattingly, atty, appeared on behalf of Mr. Frank Latham and requested repairs on old Medley's Neck Road. Mr. Briscoe asked to ascertain whether or not this road is private or public road.

Board ordered publication of Dog Notice in all papers. All dog owners required to secure tags not later than Sept. 1st inst.

Deed executed for small tract of land from Alms House Farm-woodland- to Wm. C. Gatton, et ux. Cons. \$156.00. Paid.

Discussion re status Lexington Park and Carver Heights Housing areas and status Mr. Naccollet, as Technical Advisor to Planning and Zoning Board; should Navy dispense with his services. Mr. Briscoe to report to Board on this question.
