REQUESTS FOR ROAD IMPROVEMENT

Col. Walter L. Simpson appeared complaining of "Old Manor Road" advises he gave 1 mi 20ft Right of Way to straighten out road. At that time road was gravelled. Engineer advised him to let same remain until gravel settled. Needs gravel and oil. Matter referred to Mr. Thompson for attention.

St. Mary's City to St. James School Road in very bad condition. Deep ditches at top of hill, both sides of road. Should have "CAUTION" signs. Mr. Thompson advises County has no signs and agrees road is bad and needs attention.

Clerk instructed to notify all Bus Contractors to appear at Special Meeting Tues Sept. 2 to renew contracts. Also to have Mr. J.R. Drury to appear, re bonds.

County Expenses ordered published in two newspapers in County- St. Mary's Beacon and St. Mary's Enterprise.

✓ Bridge at Sand Gates reported in bad condition. Mr. Thompson advises material has been ordered and same will be repaired.

Atty. W.O.E. Sterling appeared re 2 dogs kept tied in vicinity of home of Thos. F. Buckler. Says dogs howl at night and are nuisance- dogs have tags. County has no jurisdiction over matter but will request Sheriff to ask dog owner to keep same quiet.

✓ Mr. Hines appeared with Real Estate Agent requesting County erect a 3 ft. stob barrier across property adjacent to beach at Sand Gates to prevent trucks and cars from parking along beach thus spoiling it for bathers. Says they have prepared parking area for 3-400 cars have had beach dragged and cleaned and all trash removed. Also set up cans for trash of picnickers. Will furnish material for stobs if County will have same erected as they have no post hole diggers. Mr. Briscoe to ascertain legality of matter and advise Mr.

Hines if same can be done.

County Comm. later acquired additional land (now owned by Dixon Bros) in order that public might have room to store pulpwood waiting for shipment. County will resurvey road and put markers, beginning at stream, to show location of Public Landing which is to be kept open.
