In view of this the action of the County Commissioners in denying
the use of the Court House on Sept. 10th. 1947, for the purpose of holding
a public meeting of the St. Mary's County Civic Association was arbitrary,
discriminatory, inconsiderate and undemocratic.

This action has brought ill repute on the good name of St.
Mary's County and is most unbecoming to public officials entrusted with
the dignity of the Office.
