Kavanaugh SJ transportation of school children to St. Joseph's 68- too many for one bus trip, necessitated making 2 trips, 20 extra miles per day. Extra money due Fr. Kavanaugh from Sept to date included in check #767 Trans. New contract now reads for \$2491.20

St. Geo. Island.

Mr. Lawrence Henderson appeared in re: fill-in at bulkhead at island. Recent storms washed away 6 ft. Mr. King wrote and talked to Mr. Chency in re: fill in. Awaiting letter from SRC However, since each rain washes away more of the island, it was deemed expedient to employ Mr. Lester A. Mattingly to start fill in work. Mr. Briscoe instructed to prepare contract Mr. Mattingly to sign same. All labor and material to be furnished \$1.25 per cu yd, exclusive of top soil. Mr. Mattingly agrees to start work and in the event SRC will do the work and State pay for it, he will cancel his contract when SRC desires start work. Otherwise, he will complete the job. Deemed wise to carry in bulldozer and slope land belonging to Torpedo Testing Range at P9ney Pt. Lieut. Comm. Glennon contacted by phone. Gave permission to grade land, but not to use same for fill-in except on land belonging to Navy. Will meet Mr. Mattingly

Building Permit #2 granted to Mr. Chas. Beal of Leanardtown for erection of 1½ story bungalow, frame structure, at St. Clements Shores, valued at \$5,000.

Next meeting falls on Tues Dec 9, date of Special Elec. Bd. postponed meeting to Dec 16, 1947. Mr. King granted leave of absence until Dec 16, Mrs. King to substitute in his place at no cost to County.
