Electrical Board

A meeting was held between the Commissioners, Barnard I. Smith, Pres., of the Bd. of Electrical Examiners and Chas. Moore sec., with Mr. Allan Dameron and his attorney Mr. WOE Sterling. Mr. Dameron claims he has had difficulty in contacting the E,ec. Board with reference to results of his examination. Mr. Sterling asked for a review of his examination

Mr. Briscoe read from the Law applying to Elec Exams and suggested that if the Elec. Bd complied with the rules and regulations as set forth, and insist that applicants should do as required

Applications to be filed 30 days prior to examination  
Result of exams to be made known immediately after the date of exam, and applicants to be notified by Registered Mail and Return Receipt kept for proof of mailing. All communications should be handled by Registered Mail

Mr. Smith had with him small metal box in which he kept copies of letters sent, Registered receipts etc., He says he is very busy and if Board would like to appoint someone in his position it would be agreeable

Mr. Briscoe again emphasized the necessity of following rules etc., and if Elec Bd did this, everything should work out to the best advantage of all. Examinations should be held under the rules and regulations pertaining to the Electrical Board.
