## RESOLUTION

Whereas the Board of County Commissioners, finding certain quarters in the Court House at Leonardtown, Md., inadequate feel it advisable to make certain changes in rooms now occupied by the several offices in said Court House,

Resolve that the only possible solution to the overcrowding of the several offices is to make the following changes, which are therefore

Ordered by the Board of Commissioners of St. Mary's County, Md., on the day above writtent- viz

1 The office of the Trial Magistrate and Sub Trial Magistrate and Sheriff will be located on the 2nd floor of the Court House, in the room now occupied by Mr. Lacey which he is using with the understanding that when it is deemed necessary to use the room for other purposes he will vacate;

2 The room now used by the States Attorney on the 1st floor of the Court House will be used as the Law Library where the law books in constant use will be located; the law books not used frequently will be placed in the rear of the room formerly used by the Trial Magistrate and which will now be used by the Board of Commissioners for St. Mary's County;

3 The room now used as the Law Library will be cleared and used by the office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court and his staff;

4 The States Attorney's office will now be located in the room used by the Grand Jury;

5 The room used by the Commissioners will be used by Mr. George Lawrence, Supervisor of Assessments and Mr. Lacey.

6 Offices used by the Board of Education, the Register of Wills, the County Treasurer, the Petit Jury will remain unchanged
