The Board of Commissioners met in regular session today, Capt. M.R. Bailey and Frank Bailey present. Mr. J.F. Raley is ill.

Mr. Raymond Quade appeared relative to crowding on his bus-93 children. He and Mr. Frank Bailey will revamp his route before Sept. and Mr. Bailey relieve him of some of the load and increase Mrs. Alberta Bailey's route.

Mr. Geo. Lawrence appeared with relative to personal property tax, Bd. decided to reduce taxes by 50%

Mr. Gibson appeared requesting check for 7th Dist Vol Fire Dept same was given him \$700.00 (as prescribed by law-) for 1950

Board of Education

Board met with Commissioners to request the purchase of an 18 acre site of land in old Texas - J.M. Mattingly's property - land almost all level runs with street, has water, lights, fire dept. etc facilities which make it adaptable for school site. Dr. Pullen viewed land and decided it would be a good plan to purchase the entire tract of 18 Acres and hold it until Leonardtown Primary and High School is built. Bd. left at noon to view the property in question. They made no commitment as to whether they would pay any part of this \$18,000, nor did they know from what source the money would come - Incentive Fund or school loan etc. No decision made at all. **Capt. Bailey desires to have Bd present before any decision is made.**

Miss Dent advised the Bd. of Educa. is dedicated to major projects Mech and Bancker - 3rd is to be in Hollywood before Ltn school is built. (Projected completed today with regards to exchange of land with Mr. Dean etc.) This latter information came from Mr. Claude Johnson who called to see what decision the Commissioners had reached. They did not return for the afternoon session.

Mr. Briscoe asked if the source of the money for payment of the Mattingly tract could come from the Incentive Fund - Atty. Paul J. Bailey has not advised the Bd. of Educa. Or can it be drawn from the Bond issue? Miss Dent advised that the Bd. of Educa is already dedicated to 2 major and 1 tentative project and suggests that the Co. Com can assist towards the purchase of the land from some other source. Mr. Frank Bailey asked what amount would be required for the option. Town Com. and Chamber of Com., with PTA and other organizations express their desire that a tract of land be secured in the Ltn area and a consolidated school be erected here.

Mr. Mattingly also expressed his willingness to accept the present school site in part payment of the land. The Bd. of Educa says if the Co. Com will provide funds for the purchase of the new site - they the Bd of Educa will agree to use proceeds from the old site towards paying for the land.

Mr. B says before anything is done, tract should be surveyed.
