McKenna appeared representing a number of colored citizens, taxpayers who reside on the Clayton Rd. near St. Inigoes, Md. who have repeatedly requested that the road be accepted by the Bd. for maintenance. Previously had been accepted, staked out. Road is too bad for doctor to enter in bad weather, but priest and Minister come when called. Six taxpaying families reside on the road which is less than one mile long. No action taken.

Mrs. Sam Dyson, Great Mills requests that County accept a road near 7 Gables Hotel, serves 11 families, is 1/5 mi long road lies just beyond the lot facing the riverside. Mr. Thompson will report on this.

Jere Gibson, road running from Mattingly's Store at Abell, Md., 1/4 mi serves 2 families Mr. Thompson will report on this and if acceptable will advise Bd. then Mr. Gibson will be instructed to have Deed for R of W prepared.

Mrs. John Madel- Parochial transportation of her children is still unsatisfactory. Board advised Mrs. Madel she was to contact Mr. Hebb, or his driver, and whatever decision they made between them would be agreeable to Board.

Flat Iron Rd. Mr. Thompson was asked to have this road gravelled before winter sets in.

Newtown Neck Rd- Ridge Peter Fenwick says road is good now- but if extended .01 mi would serve two additional families road also needs grading as it is near a very high ditch. Mr. Thompson was asked if road will be gravelled this fall. He will report on road.

Mr. Frank Bailey says all roads requested for improvements should be taken in the order in which they are requested.

Mr. Briscoe attended the Civil Defense meeting at Upper Marlboro and a second meeting will be held in Washington on Oct 17th- in which Mr. Walter B. Raley was asked to represent the Bd. of Co. Com. Mr. Nicolet will go with Mr. Thompson and they will make a report.

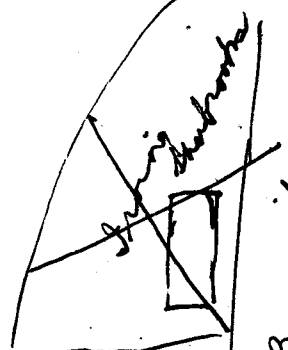
