

April 3, 1951

All members of the Board of Commissioners and their attorney were present when the Board met today for Special Session.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Erosion Project

A group of taxpayers from Tall Timbers, represented by Lt. Comdr. Downs, with County Surveyor Wm. Bowman, and Mr. Nicolet were here to consider the problem of soil erosion at Tall Timbers. A survey had been prepared by Mr. Bowman showing the shore line where protection is necessary. There are already some jetties erected by owners along this line, and it is felt they would not be agreeable to sell their jetties to the County and come in under the protection, as that would mean they would also have to pay the special Erosion Relief Tax. A lengthy discussion was held as to methods of preparing for the installation of the jetties. It is hoped to have Mr. Thompson and Mr. Singewald, geologist, present at a later meeting, but the consensus of opinion is that some concessions must be made for those already having their jetties. Mr. Juenman said there are a number of property owners in that area who desire to come in under the erosion protection, but they have failed to co-operate with reference to the Community in ~~Opads~~ etc., and should not be considered. Mr. Sterling explained that this protection is for the Tall Timbers section only.

It was decided to authorize Mr. Bowman to establish a line and go ahead with the plans;

a short jetty is most practical, 24 ft long 30 ft. apart
Amount of payments must be established

Petitions must be prepared for lot owners to sign, giving
their address and number of lots they own so it
can be easily checked on plat

Public meeting to be held, and notices sent out to all
property owners so they can attend

Mr. Bowman will make drawing and Comdr. Downs will have copies
made to send to each lot owner, showing the line for
erosion protection

Mr. Thompson will have to prepare plans showing cross sections
Mr. Thompson, Nicolet and Bowman will inspect the present sea
walls and jetties

Mr. Guy suggested the owners of the seawalls be reimbursed for
such protection, less the cost of their proportion of the
project, then they will come in under the tax erosion
plans

Dr. Gambles feels Mr. Foxwell knows a good deal about this wall
and should be present

Cmdr. Downs feels the figures should be from the Beach line back
and property owners should be pro-rated according to location of
their lots. Mr. Thompson has figures on ratio in Anne Arundel Co

It is estimated it will require several weeks before all signa-
tures are received and then the Public meeting should be held.

After the Public meeting the Bd. of Co. Com will decide whether to continue the project and have jetties etc erected

Next step will be to establish the Erosion District -boundaries etc., and get bids for the installation of the jetties and sea wall, then set the tax

Mr. Alvey inspected the piece of road Otis Wood wants repaired Mr. Wood was advised if other families used the road it could be repaired, but could not be done for just one family.

Mr. Stone and Mr. Thompson were to see Mr. Hira, Millison and ask if he desired any part of the abandoned road Mr. Hardin wanted. Mr. Thompson was ill and they did not contact Mr. Millison.

It was established that the clerk in the Sheriff's office is to work for both the sheriff and the State Troopers .

R of W for Hermanville Road presented by Atty Wm.M.Loker, Jr. (No record of this was found in old minutes. Mr. Thompson contacted and he advised name of road is 3 Notch Pt. Rd., and previous Bd had agreed to accept road on receipt of DEED - Nov 14 minutes)

Mr. J.Frank Bailey, Treas came in to say he will pay half the salary of the two clerks who are preparing the 1951 tax bills.

Ambrose Wood called to advise he is not being paid for all the route he drives. Mr. Bailey says he is, Mr. Guy will measure Mr. Wood's entire route to establish the mileage.

1st aid kits were handed to Mr. Bailey for
Bailey- Roberts-Beachum. \$14.65 each frt. makes them \$15

Bd. of Education presented a request for additional State School Loan of \$300,000.00, 3 copies of this were signed by the Bd. and one is filed under Bd. of Education

Bd. requested letter to sheriff asking him to appear on Tues.
