Special Meeting

A Special Meeting was held today to consider the Budget for 1951-52 and to open bids for the construction of the New County Health and Office Building. All members and their attorney were present.

Tall Timbers

Comdr. Downs appeared relative to the Public Hearing for the Tall Timbers project, which he felt should be held as soon as possible in order that work may be completed before the fall storms set in. Board agreed to hold the hearing on Monday July 3 at 10 a.m. Notices of this meeting were sent to both County papers.

Public Hearing on the Budget for 1951-52 will be held Saturday June 30, at ten a.m.

Alms House

Mr. Parran Graves, inmate of the Alms House requested that members of the Board come to the Alms House to consider conditions there. He also reported that he purchased 2 shirts and 1 pr. of trousers for \$9.07 and the Supt. would not pay for them. He was advised the Supt. is allowed \$25 per month for each inmate and from that should furnish and clothe them with necessary clothing. Board agreed to visit the Alms House this evening.

Trial Magistrate

Clerk was asked to inform Mr. Knight, sub-trial magistrate that while he is acting Trial Magistrate he is entitled to more salary which would be deducted from Mr. Hurry's salary. Mr. Knight said he was satisfied with his own salary

County Council PTA

Mrs. Egeli representing the GMHS PTA- and Mr. Hayward of the MBHS PTA County Council, with Miss Dent, came relative to the serious situation facing the public schools today. Out of a staff of 117 teachers 45 have resigned. This was due to lack of increase in salary. Board had allocated \$9,200 for 1951 but this only covered the teachers in the low brackets.

At 2 p.m. Mr. Frederick Tilp, architect, opened the bids on the New Health and County Office Bldg. About 30 interested citizens were present. Bids were as follows
