Regular Meeting.

All members of the Board were present at the regular meeting held today.

DEED for R of W-mortgage release from Robt. Blackistone recd. This is for the road at 7 Gables.

Alex Hebb came in to report that his bus no longer picks up Dr. Patrick's child, but does go over the Claude Abell and Carroll Jarboe road, which makes the route the same distance as before, as well as cutting off 10 minutes of time. He asked that the bushes be cut from the road and road be cleaned out. Says it is a good gravel road. Mr. Thompson was advised and says he will get busy there soon.

Mrs. Clarence Guy came to see about bus transportation for her children attending St. Mary's Academy. Board advised her to have them go on the St. Jos. bus and transfer where it meets the Academy bus, but she says the 1st bus is about 10 min too late for this. Transportation will be worked out for the children

Mrs. Elmo Guy came about the same situation.

Mrs. Miller came about the R of W thru Mr. VanWard's famr and was told by Mr. Alvey that he had been over there and had hopes that a roadway could be worked out soon.

Clerk was requested to inform the So.Md. Elec. Co-Op that the Commissioners are exempt from Sales tax and to request the amount they have paid so it could be claimed. Letter was written to this effect.

Dec 11 10 a.m. was set for Tax Review of new assessments in the 1st and 8th Districts.

Dec 17 set for Bus examinations and meeting of Commissioners for pay day.

Clerk was requested to write the Sheriff and send copy of resolutions regarding parking in Lexington Park Area. This was done. Resolutions are to be enforced.

Letter was addressed to Mr. M.C. Thompson, Jr., requesting that obstruction at ~~front~~ of Public Landing at the end of the White Neck Creek road be moved.

Tax Rate was set for the year <sup>July 1</sup> ~~July 1~~, 1952-~~June 30, 1953~~ at \$1.50 per \$100. Assessable basis was \$19,436,000.00

Letter received from Public Improvements Bureau advising they have no jurisdiction over repairs to roof of jailor's bungalow. Board will have repairs made and pay for them. Mr. Sterling says it is not necessary to secure a Public bud unless repairs are \$500 or over. Mr. Alvey says to have the roof repaired in the leak, and then have whole roof tarred.

Letter from Jos.D.Weiner, relative to property he purchased at Tax Sale. Same has been under water for several years. Agreed to give him refund.

Mr. Duke made request for 1951-52 allotment for the Leonardtown Vol. Fire Dept \$700.00- was granted

Board signed request for \$55,000.00 grant from the State for Mechanicville School.

Mr. Sterling was directed to prepare a letter to the Sheriff instructing him to collect delinquent Personal Property Schedule taxes.

Mr. Frank Bailey says the dogs killing Mrs. Drury's and Arthur Briscoe's turkeys belong to L. Vallandingham. Letter was addressed to Game Warden advising him of this.
