

April 22, 1952

All members present today when the Board met .

Thos Waring of Waring & Son was requested to make a survey for Accident insurance, Liability- for the County and same will cost between 2 and 3\$00 per year for \$100,000.00 personal injury and \$500,000 per accident, this is for all buildings etc which the County owns.

Mrs. John Ferrari, requested road at Brubacher's, Britton Beach, be repaired. The road begins at Wigginton's and has bad turn and soft shoulders.

Health Dept presented their budget for 1952-53 Board will consider matter with Budget, tho 1st page was passed as presented. Matter of sanitarian and eye and hearing tests will be considered later.

X Letter to Boys Club of Washington, including part of reply from State Tax Commission states that Boys Camp is not tax exempt.

PTA- Hollywood, Ltn. Charlotte Hall- NSES- and Patuxent River Base came for interview and matter of teachers salary raise. A copy of the proceedings is on file. Letter to Lt. Comdr. Henderson advised permission to have same printed was not granted. A lengthy interview followed. No answer could be given since the Budget had not been prepared and the County Commissioners did not know how much would be available. There was no consideration given the matter when the tentative budget was prepared in Nov. since it was understood the Governor would pass the Bill and the State would be liable for the increases.

Rosecroft- addition to road when DEED has been recorded and presented to Commissioners.

Mr. M.M. Dean interested in the Dean-Capps Road in Hollywood was advised that the road must be 30 ft wide with ditches on either side, outside the 30 ft. 3 inch gravel base with proper drainage/ Light poles which are in the middle of the proposed roadbed must be removed. Mr. Dean was advised by this over the phone while Mr. Thompson was here.

Plat and DEED received from Mr. John A. Brickley. He was advised by letter that same must be recorded at no expense to the County.

Hospital Delegation- Mrs. Hayden, Mr. Burroughs and Mr. Hartwell. Stated importance of the hospital and of a resident physician on hand to handle emergencies. This would cost about \$600 a month. It costs \$12.17 overall cost per patient per day. They spoke of the necessity of enlarging the hospital. The Board agreed to take the matter under consideration and would do what it could.

Leonardtwn School- Bd. of Education advises they are anxious to see a good school in Leonardtown. Mr. Alvey asked if the present school and site now used could be sold and that money

held for the new school in Leonardtown. Commissioners are anxious to have a reply from the Bd. of Education stating just what they will allocate for this school. Letter written in Feb. 1952. No reply to date.

Fair Board requests that lot of Mrs. Ridgell's, adjoining the grounds of the Fair lot, be purchased in order to square off the proposed Race Track. Mrs. Ridgell is on Welfare- Mr. Henry Fowler will contact Welfare and see if she can sell the lot. He ascertained it could be purchased for \$75 and she could keep that much money. The question now is whether the Fair Board or the County Commissioners will purchase the lot.

Wilson Butler- road near Miss Mary Dixon's is in need of drainage children cannot get out to go to school after bad rain.
