Mrs.Wm.Hayden came in about this road. The Bd. and Mr. Thompson agreed to meet her at 4:30 pm in Chaptico to see what-if anything can be done to help. In 1951 Mrs Hayden was advised that if R of W could be secured the Bd. would accept it. This has not been done as yet.

Miss Mary Dixon requested repairs etc to road which would cost between \$8 and \$10 thousand dollars Cannot be done. She was so advised by letter.

Mr. Tilp came in about the steps to the new County and Health Office Bldg advising they would not cost extra. He also looked at the corridor in the Court House which the Bd desired to have partitioned off so they would have 2 more rooms in the Court House. He will send sketches at end of this week.

Mrs. Hayden asked about the salary of resident physician to Hospital- Bd agreed they would pay \$6,00 per year not \$7,200 as asked. Physician to be paid monthly when he comes.

Clerk authorized to purchase 3 ven. blinds for office of Clerk of the Circuit Court.

Mrs. Geo. Boyd requested repairs to Baptist Ch road-says when it rains 2 cars cannot pass as part of road was washed out in recent storm. Bd will look at road and report at next meeting.
