Mr. Koehler and attorney Alvord came about the R of W thru Mr. Koehler's property at Patuxent Beach. After lengthy discussion Mr. Koehler's attorney suggested the lot be surveyed and a report made to Board at a later date about how much of Mr. Koehler's property has been taken for the new road.

J.L.Mattingly, coin operated machine inspector was asked to inspect machines at Banagan's Drive-In, Lex.Pk and Lloyd Bean's Ridge, for license on Pin Ball machines

Mrs.Miller again asked that something be done so she can have access to her home thru winter. Mr. VanWard will not cooperate in the matter. There has been a verbal agreement for many years prior to this that R of W thru farm was agreeable but there is no written record of this agreement. Board will give this matter further consideration

Mr. MacMorman called with reference to parking meters in Lex Pk but he says the Park is not ready to have them.

Dec 8 Bd of Education, Miss Dent et al, asked to meet with Commissioners when PTA of River Springs and elsewhere is present to speak about interchange of transportation between Parochial and Public busses. Letter from Mr. Toombs concerning this matter was answered and he also requested to be present Dec 8.

Letter to Mr. H. Kendall King, Hollywood advising that road thru his subdivision will be accepted by County after survey is made and DEED recorded not later than Dec 12, 1953 Needs 3 copies of survey- SRC needs 2, and Land Records need 1

Letter addressed to Commanding Officer, NATCUSN, advising that at this time County has no funds with which to complete the Jarboesville-Willows road.

Lieut. Ramsey, Lex Pk requested to appear Dec 8 at 2:30 to answer charge of complaints that he is violating Fire regulations and Planning & Zoning laws .
