USA Eng. Dorps advised that the entrance channel from St. Clements Bay to St. Patrick's creek- to be 7 ft deep and 60' wide, is under contemplation. Letter advised this was urgently needed and property owners and County willing to fulfill obligations with reference to costs, R of W etc. as set forth in letter from Lt. Col. R.V. Dague.
