

August 9, 1955

Today's meeting was attended by all members of the Board and their attorney.

Letter was sent to M.C.Thompson, Jr to lay pipe at entrance to Leonardtown Pub school this week. Bd. of Education will pay for the pipe.

Miss Ethel Joy, Home Demonstration Agent, with Mrs. Lowe came to talk about the appointment of an Asst. H.D.A. after lengthy discussion it was determined that Miss Joy would contact several persons who might be qualified to fill this position. If possible someone from the County will be appointed, if no countian is qualified then Extension Service will make the appointment.

Dr. A.D.Houser, Dr. Robt. Locke, atty Wm. M. Loker, Jr., and the 3 members of the Md. State Legislature with several citizens of Great Mills area, called about the desired sewage and water system for that area. The area covered would be about 4 miles long on both sides of the road. Atty estimates an engineering survey of the project would cost about \$1,000 to \$1,500 and asks that the Comms advance this sum. Private security arrangements could be made by parties to be affected if the project is undertaken, or attorney suggested perhaps the Commissioners would pay half this expense. It may be necessary to enact special legislation to do this work, if the Commissioners decide to go along with it. It was pointed out that the same group asking the Bd. to spend about \$100,000 for the project is the same group who opposed the Trailer law requiring them to pay 50% no tax for the use of schools, roads, police and fire protection etc. Dr. Houser advised that unless something is done the St. Mary's River may have to be closed due to contamination, and that this relief matter is a must. He also stated that no more Bldg Permits should be issued for this area until something is determined. Board agreed to take the matter under advisement and let Mr. Loker know their decision as soon as it is reached.
