Phone call from Mrs Herman Martin asking that bus leave Medley's Neck earlier- one child attending SMAcademy always arrives after classes have started. Paul Bell's bus, leaves for Lex.Pk at 7:20 and carries children to Fr. Andrew White, on return picks up children in Medley's Neck region

Fr. Wilkinson, director of Parochial school transportation, with Mr. George Dederrer from USNATC, asked that County pay for pupil transportation from Base this year \$1683.00 after discussion Board agreed to this and Commanding Officer at Base was so advised. Letter was sent with check for Sept and Oct, as this service must be paid for in advance.

O R Guyther, representing Robert Lee Miles, complained about establishing Dog Pound at Moore's corner, opposite SRC garage. They were advised Pound would be located at rear of lot purchased and Board does not feel dogs will be kept there long enough to annoy neighbors. The lot was purchased in part for storage of SRC equipment.

Letter to Mr. M.C.Thompson, Jr., requesting that SRC erect some temporary fences at County Fair Grounds, using the storm fence on hand.

Dr. Robt. Locke, Health Dept called about license for scavengers in cleaning out septic tanks-some unlicensed persons in County charge as much as \$75 or more- only State regulation is that scavenger must have truck with name and address on it- Asks that Commissioners as Board of Health set the license fee at \$100.00 per year- no action.

Unlicensed Trailer Camps- colored man named Suter has number of trailers in his lot, gypsies mostly-they are a health menace as there is no proper sanitation at this lot-was advised Health Dept can have warrant sworn out for unlicensed trailer park operation- gypsies were warned to leave the County. Health Dept would like an ordinance like the Pub Health ordinance for adoption in St Mary's County in the future. ask for authority to draft such an ordinance. Commissioners-as Board of Health-agreed to have such an ordinance prepared.

Mr. and Leo Bean's route- Redman Bean is to check road beyond Red Barn to Cosden's to see if good road for all weather and space for turning at Piney Pt Shores to go for Cosden's child. Bus passes Red Barn at 7:15 would need about 5-8 minutes to go up the road for this boy.

Clerkinstructed to write letter and send same by registered mail to Barker Sign Co for check issued in overpayment for sign at Welfare Bldg. \$35.00

Oliver T Milburn, TT complains about neighbors red dog killing his chickens- dog not tagged belongs to Claudia Robinson TT-letter written to Robinson advising he must buy tags for all his dogs and if they kill any more chickens he will either have to pay for damage claims or destroy the dog.

Letter to Beacon and Enterprise answering that of W L George appearing in both papers Sept 15, relative to parochial school transportation for children in Lex Pk area.
