

October 11, 1955

Regular meeting held today; all members and their attorney in attendance.

Group from Lexington Park Methodist Church came about the installing of sidewalks etc on church property. Where they desire to make a new parking lot is at the intersection of GM Road and Shangri-La-very busy intersection and dangerous. The Planning and Zoning Commission approved a parking lot- the one now in use- and they feel the new one is not necessary and should not be made at the spot picked out. Group was composed of Messrs T.G. Strickland-Rev Bowen, Raul Bennetta Chas Choke Chas Wright Emerson Chesser

Mr. Chesser remained to ask about the increase in salary for teachers. Competing against the Civo. Service employees at the NATC base clerks receive \$2600 entrance fee and within 3 yrs increase to 2900. Board will consider this, after for the 56-57 Budget.

Dr. Houser asks for increase in salary of Mr. Wiley Hartwell who is doing a splendid job as Plumbing Inspector and Sanitation agent-began at his own suggestion \$2400 Dr. H feels Mr. Hartwell should receive the same compensation as Mr. Mast, Sanitation agent who now gets \$3570 with an automatic increase of \$125.00 for the next 4 years. Board will consider the matter at next meeting.

Representatives of the State Roads Commission called to explain about the change in County and State Roads system- No decision on part of Board.

Atty Wm.M. Loker with Mr. James Hill of Hill's Trailer Park, Great Mills Road came to inquire if a provision could be placed in any new law dealing with County installed sewage and water along the GM highway whereby Mr. Hill would not have to join up should he now put in a \$10,000 disposal plant in accordance with the demands of the County Health Dept that he have proper sewage etc. Altho there is at present no such County project in view, the Commissioners advised that should such a law be contemplated they would try to have Mr. Hill's present- or new-plant considered so that he would not lose his \$10,000.00

Mr. Thompson and Mr. Stone will meet to view the proposed parking lot, sidewalks etc at the Methodist church property in Lexington Park, also Rose Croft and report at next meeting.

Walter Countiss on the Higdon Road to be advised it is not a County road and therefore nothing can be done.
