After lengthy discussion the Commissioners agreed to allocate an additional \$444,000 which will not be needed until after January 1, 1957. The building is now to have 4 class and 1 multipurpose room, but the heating and sewage are so arranged that 6 extra rooms can be added later and the two above systems will not have to be changed.

Mr. Bernard McKay, Valley Lee,Md., came in to make arrangements to pay \$100 per year for hospitalization of his daughter <u>Emma E McKay</u>, who hae been a patient in Rosewood Tr. Sch since 1918. Mr Alvey said it would be agreeable if this is the best Mr. McKay can do, Payment will be made semi-annually. Receipt was given Mr. McKay for Jan 1 to une 30, 1956.

Mr. Frank Alvey came in about selling price of Lots 39 and 40 in Bl 30advising they are \$20.00 each. He asked that no decision be made about selling them to Mr. Wilkinson until he ascertained who owned the lots between Wilkinson's property and these lots as he does not think they adjoin Wilkinson's property. Board will withhold their decision until Mr. Frank Alvey contacts them later.
