All members and their attorney were present at today's general session.

Waring's Sub-div- Horse Head Road 8th Elec Dist Mr. Waring came in about the County accepting Road must be properly built, pass inspection and DEED recorded for R of W to County before County can accept the roads.

Plumbing Inspection- All houses built under FHA are allowed \$25.00 in the loan to cover Plumbing inspections. Most Counties charge \$45.00 for percolation test and \$50-\$75 for inspection, St Mary's County charges \$3.00 for each such test. If we raised the price for this work it would assist in paying the Health Dept budget.

Dr Houser and Mr Hartwell spoke of the Trailer Camp Law- Code of 49-Chap 580 Sec23 New camps must obtain permit to operate before they can be opened- \$100 fine for both owner and operator if this is violated. Health Dept authorized to go ahead and publish this notice in both County papers.

Dr Houser requested that letter be sent to Mr. Gaines, State Health Dept advising that budget for 1956-57 had been accepted in full, \$23,240. This was done.

Mr. Sam Bailey was instructed to discontinue transporting Owens old except to Old Gum stop.

Clerk ^{also} requested ^{to} write letter advising that County Commissioners approve salary of \$12.50 per day for jurors, and also approve law setting minimum salary and requirements for operation of office of States Attorney

Judge Digges asked that Commissioners pay bill for Law Library Books, up to approximately \$1100.00. Formerly these books were purchased from fines of the Tr. Magistrates' Court. Other counties provide for these books in their budgets approx. \$300.00 Board agreed to consider matter and reply at next meeting. (After consultation with Mr. Sterling they decided to pay for the books).
