When the Commissioners and their attorney met this morning in general session, Dr. James T. Gamble of Tall Timbers came in to ask when repairs were anticipated for the seawall in that area. He also advised that a ditch he had requested be dug on Mr. Martin's lot was in a bad place, he was advised the Board would contact Mr. Thompson and see what could be done about this. Mr. Thompson is expected in this afternoon.

Dr. Houser came in to report that no corrections had been made by Mr. Spencer of Great Mills whose apts and bldgs there are allowing their sewage to drain in the St Mary's river. Repeated efforts on Dr Houser's and Dr Locke's part have been ineffective to have Mr. Spencer correct this matter. Board advised Dr Houser to have warrants issued charging Mr Spencer with this violation and perhaps that would hurry matters. Mr. Spencer complains that Mr. Coombs is also violating the Health regulations but nothing is being done about that.
