

May 17, 1957

This morning Mr. E. C. Duncan, Dist. Engr. SRC, with Douglas Bond and Aubrey Cusaks of the County SRC, met with the full Board of County Commissioners to talk about roads here, Mr. Thompson having been transferred to Upper Marlboro section.

Federal Aid Secondary roads- FAS money is available where SRC specifications are followed- survey- 40' R of W 9" impacted gravel bed
St Andrews Church Road- relocate at Bridge, survey has been made, pipe and bar pits can be a Fed. Aid job
Stephens Road-Hermanville- also FAS road, As well as Horsehead and Abell's Wharf
Commissioners will ask that road starting at Court House to Oliver Guyther property be built according to SRC specifications

Bulkhead at 7 Gables- must be advertised for bids on this, SRC will turn money over to Commissioners- this will need a survey, plans and specs for use in advertising- SRC will do the survey and plans and send bill to Commissioners
Mr. Thompson has sketch showing type of bulkhead to be constructed.

SRC will look into report that manhole on road in front of Lexington Park Public school -is a storm sewer- County cannot improve property for individual but if this manhole is of benefit to the public then County will repair same. Mr. Bond will report next meeting about this.

Part of Mt. Pleasant Road- Schmalgemeyer and Umphrey Smith at Hollywood, to be considered.

Board of Education came in the afternoon to confer on possibility of increase in teachers' salaries. Bd. of Ed. feels all should be increased across the board \$500.00 Lengthy discussion followed. Decision was to increase salaries \$500 across the board, for all teachers with BA degree or who meet the proper State certification. \$90,000.00 was promised. Bd. of Ed. desired to talk about Bldg program and are to come in next meeting with request for consideration.
