All members and Mr. Sterling were present today.

Mr. Sweeney of Baltimore office Internal Rev. came to advise that there are no funds in budget to pay for room in Court House. Asked if local office could remain in County Office Bldg. That room has already been designated for the County Agent, and there is no alternative but to move to the Court House. He will advise later if they can pay for office.

Clerk authorized to have man in jail paint the jail walls where necessary and pay him \$2.00 per day-to begin Monday.

Wilmer Bowles, for the Town Commissioners came in about the sidewalk and retaining wall at Court House. After long discussion Board advised him the Town Commissioners should go ahead, have the necessary work done and the County will split the cost 50-50. Large power pole is right where sidewalk is to be laid-will see if pole can be removed.

Town Creek Citizens Association wants roads beautified-hills graded etc. No action

Deputy Geo. Sanger came in with plans for the Dog Pound. He had been to Pr. Frederick and brought back information for a proper Pound-same will cost \$13,000 without the land. He was told to inquire of property owners who had land available and report where same was located and price asked for same. No definite action taken.

Dr. Locke and Mr. Hartwell reported unsatisfactory conditions at Sand Gates where Robt. Hayden has located trailer next to store and proposed to use same septic tank etc for trailer. According to new law 217L-Parking prohibited all trailers after a period of 30 days must be parked in a proper parking lot for Trailers.

Board will ask Mr. Sterling to interpret new law.
