Plans and specifications for the proposed sidewalk and retaining wall at west side of Court House not ready-Mr. Bowles will have them next week, if possible.

Date set for interview with Ed. of Education to consider School Bldg program, July 22 at 3 pm

Miss Dent asked that if and when the rooms now occupied by the County Agent are vacated could same be used by Bd. of Education. The colored Supt of schools, his assistant and clerk are coming in and need rooms in the County Office Bldg, and the Bd. of Education is already overcrowded in its present quarters. Permission was gramted, and also key to Conference Room in that building to be given to Miss Dent since County Agent will use either the Gen eral Conference or Trial Court Room in Court House when his staff moves.
