All members and their attorney were in session today.

Dr. Houser advised that the population of St. Mary's County is 38,000 which does not include the Navy personnel on the base at NATC.

Dr. Houser asked that the money allocated for the salary of 2 nurses for the months of Oct-Nov and Dec. 1957 be used for the expenses of an additional Mental Health Clinic for those 3 months - the nurses are on leave without pay and this extra clinic will be an additional expense to the County. agreed to this.

Delegate J. Frank Relev called about a road bond for the Bay Harbor Development Corporation in the 1st District. Douglas Bond advised it would be a Performance Bond. Mr. Raley was advised that before this matter can be considered there would have to be a permit issued by the Planning & Zoning Commission for a development at that area, that road would have to be built according to BRC specifications and also a permit from the Health Dept fortproper water and sewage disposal.

Hollywood Vol Gire Dept asked for letter to Fed. Com. Commission of Wash DC advising that this organization was actively engaged in this County.

SHC- Mr. E.C. Dunca, District Engineer, Kenneth Webb, Asst. of Upper Marlboro and J.D.Bond, resident engineer came in with plans for the bulkhead at Seven Gables. There was a question as to whether or not the Commissioners to have the entire roadbed the same sealevel- it is 4 ft in one place and 7 ft in other places. The Bd will meet with the SRC at 7 Gables Monday Occober 14 at 1:30 to determine this.

At 9 a.m. Wednesday, Oct 9 Mr. Alvey and J.D. Bond will meet with Mr. Henry Fowler on the Queen Tree road matter to determine at which end the road will be started. (Decision to build from inside and come out to 235.)

Frank A. Comb was asked to have a representative of the North American Insurance Co appraise the Court House and determine the amount of insurance to be carried then the policies will be divided among the insurance agents here.

Frank Combs requested clerk to address a letter to him, as member of the State Legislature, asking that the Employees Retirement System Bill be amended in order that the employees of the County Commissioners can be eligible for this retirement as of the day they were eligible for Social Security.

Architect Fred Tilp came in about the last inspection of the Court House. He was appointed by the Building Committee to represent them and determine when the Court House was ready for acceptance.

Sign sent in and later returned to the Lamb Seal & Stencil Co was ordered for the Court House at LaPlata. - sign reads not to turn on switch unless window is opened 4 inches.
