River Naval Command, US Naval Gun Factory-Wash DC, concerning the possibility that taxes from Center Gardens may cease this will eliminate approximately \$1,000,000 from the taxing property of the County. Copy of the letter was sent to Rep. Lankford at his request.

Check for \$27,204.51 was sent to MM Dean, contractor for the Court House-\$1,000 was withheld until all minor errors are corrected. Mr. Tilp approved the payment.
