Later a request for Bids will be advertised and when Bid is let, work will be started.

SRC- from Hermanville to Woody's Bar .7 mi- McInerney Road, was accepted with DEED 4-12-51 Liber CBG 30 folio 185 Road is in 1959 Construction Program Road should be rebuilt but only have 30' R/W which cannot be accepted and must have 40' R/W clerk asked to inform Mr. W.E.Bowman, 10A- East Custis Ave., Alexandria, Va. as to R/W.

James Waring-complains that SRC sewers are causing water to back in sanitary sewers in Patuxent Park-sometime ago same condition occurred and State Roads repaired sewer at Midway and Hencock, found 3 joints had parted but it now appears the outlet in the woods off Midway is blocked. Where County sewers drain into Patux. Tark sanitary sewers they should be repaired. Commissioners will contact Mr. Bond about this-Mr. Waring advises the pipes are 8 and 6 in .

St. Andrews Ch. Road extension R#235 at rear of Dr. Patrick's- road has been graded, at once place water wshed the road out and gravel into ditch. Bad entrance road is 1600 ft long- 10 houses now on the road and 3 more under construction R/W now 30', but must be 40' Mr. Bond is to contact Edsel Potter after 5 pm at Vol. 3, 4191 and see what has to be done.

Court House Inspection-Results

Mr. Tilp with Mess s Garner and Smith met in the afternoon. Mr. Dean failed to attend or send a representative. Flooding of Sheriff's room caused by water not flowing thru drain but backing up under floor and coming out in front of air conditioner. Mr. Smith had pipe cleaned out but felt there was an obstruction in the lines near steps to vestibule at rear of Court House. Mr. Garner sent son to check on this and he found bags in the pipe. If they were dropped there after pipes were laid it is the fault of the contractor. Mr. Garner feels the obstruction is cleared out now. Mr. Tilp asked that janitor use several sections of hose and wash out the pipe-if water comes out on road within 10 min. pipe is clear If small pieces of pipe or gravel or other substance comes out with the water pipes are not clear and Mr. Tilp is to be advised. Mr. Dean is to pay the bill Garner Bros sent in for cleaning the pipes.

Sept 5 was set as deadline for the contractor to complete the small items still unfinished \$1,000 due entractor will not complete the work, Mr. Sterling thinks. Meferring to Mr. Tilp's letter of Aug 1, the following comments are taken Item 10B cracked plaster on original walls to be repaired by owner

- 13 crack on floor of lunch room- floor was not made level with new part and contractor should rememby this.
- 15 slope in floor of boiler room- very bad and could cause an accident electric wire there could get soaked in the water which is too low down to drain- this should be corrected at once.
 - 19 Down spouts at northern elevation not properly installed
- 20 Gutters should be cleaned frequently, also keep area clear where drain is located are replained that while crack in front door can be repaired, the screen doors are not properly hung

If Mr. Dean does not make these corrections by S pt mber 5, Mr. Tilp will advise the Commissioners to have them made and deduct the cost from amount due M . Dean \$1,000
