Dr. Locke and V. Mast, sanitarians, came in about the Percolation tests required before Bldg permits can be issued- they were advised the County insists on these test and clerk was asked not to issue Bldg permit without certification that such tests had been made. If

Mag was allowed mileage to and from County line to Annapolis, Md when he is required to attend State Police lectures etc. Also at convention at Ocean City he will be allowed mileage to and from the County line to Ocean City, hotel expenses for 2 days and 1 night. When necessary to attend other lectures he will be allowed mileage from and to the County line

Clerk requested to order 1 set Annotated Code of Md. latest edition and 50 copies Chap 594-Trailer Coach Park law.

Clerk requested to write J. Lloyd Bean and advise him to appear before the St. Mary's Planning & Zoning Commission since he has an unapproved Sub-division and is selling lots and acreage.

Attorneys preparing DEEDS should be required to give more accurate descriptions of metes and bounds. Mr. Sterling will take this up at next meeting of St Mary's Co Bar Association- he will also ask for subscriptions to pay for furniture in Lawyers' lounge

Bd. Educa- asked if there is a regulation governing the distance of bars from schools? Mr. King also asked if the Commissioners could possibly carry \$65,000 instead of \$43,170 in the 59-60 Budget-if possible Commissioners will carry this amount.

Mr. Benson- St. Clements Shores came to request something be done about the dusty roads in that sub-division would like to have oil treatment from Wigwam around shore of beach. This area will be oiled at a later date.

Mr. King to come in on June 23, at 10 a.m. to meet the Commissioners and Mr. Lipski letter to Mr. Lipski asking him to be here.

Letter to Gov. Tawes asking that he appoint Kenneth B. Duke Chairman for Keep Md. Beautiful for St Mary's County. Mr. Duke is already Town Chairman and has the time to give to this work. Mrs. King has been chrmn for 5 years but too busy Mr. Duke will address the Garden Clubs here and ask their cooperation in keeping roadsides clean. Mr. Duke advised that the Compton dump where Raymond Taylor is in charge, is in very bad condition asked that Mr. Guy pass there on his way home, to see the place.

Mr and Mrs James Hill-Hill's Trailer Court aksed about laws for such parks regarding dogs and pets. Law was sent to her.

Clerk requested to write letter to Rene H. Howard asking price of land in 7D known as the Collins lot, which Mrs. Howard owns.

Sheriff asked to investigate claim for pigs belonging to Ford Dine, Hlyd.

Road from Lee's to 3 Notch-used by Amish farmers etc to be gravelled-National Guard will do the work.

Bid from Smith's Inc and Stokel's for 4 air hillers for Welfare office--Smith's 1004.70 accepted-to be installed within 10 days.

Commissioners had long session with Mr. Cero of State Tax Commission and Supervisor J. Ralph Abell, Sr and Wm. F. Herbert regarding reassessment of all properties in an attempt to bring them onto line, at about 50% of their selling value.
