According to the Sheriff and his Deputies, there are quite a few bars staying open after hours. The law pertaining to this says-that any licensed premises, devided by a partition or not, must be vacated, that is no patrons, from 1:00 A. M. to 6:00 A. M. on weekdays and 2:00 A. M. to 6:00 A. M. on Sundays. All licensed premises must have one or more plain glass windows on the street or highway so as to enable persons standing on the ground or highway to observe the interior of the premises at all hours during which sales are prohibited. First violation of liquor laws at least a warning is given. Second violation 10 days supension. Third violation 30 days supention. Fourth violation Revocation.

The Liquor Board Inspectors said they would assist the Sheriff

and his Deputies as much as possible.
