The Commissioners agreed that 2 lights, similar to the new ones in Leonardtown, will be sufficient for the Lexington Park Shopping Center on Tulagi Pl if properly spaced. Atty Wm. Aleck Loker was advised of this and letter will be sent to Mr. Lee Willson owner of the area in question.

At ten o'clock the Commissioners and officials met with SRC Jr. Raley to talk about road conditions in general and were advised that on Monday Dec 28 Bay View Road will be gravelled.

Atty Wm. Sterling talked to the Board about the extra investigators being sent to work on the Ragan Murder case and advised that the Board should bear all expenses of this group while they are here on this matter.

Letter from SRC about Contract Plans for Md. Route #234-3.143 miles east of US 301 toward Chaptico. Plans were acknowledged by letter from clerk.

When the Board inquired about the next date for Tax Review they were advised by J. Ralph Abell, Supervisor of Assessments that the new law eliminated these reviews.

Mr. Ercole Leonardo came in about his taxes due on Tall Timbers Explosion Relief Project. He offered letter showing his debt was \$480.98 and he also offered a check for this amount. A letter dated 8-22-59 had been sent him showing his taxes due as \$588.27 at that time. This matter will be referred to auditor for his decision as to proper amount due from Leonardo. Check signed by Leonardo for \$480.98 which he insisted upon writing is being held- if he is correct check will be deposited if he is incorrect check will be returned to him, with true bill due.

Sts. Atty Jos A. Mettingly asked Commissioners about additional compensation for Deputy Geo. Sanger who is assigned full time to the Ragan case. After Commissioners talk with Deputy Sanger they will make decision.

Chas. Wood- St. Mary's City, came to ask for entrance to his property which S&C has closed. This is not a matter for the Commissioners.
