The County Commissioners and Administrative Asst with their attorney met in session today.

Dr. Houser, Health Dept., came to present the inventory of County owned property in the Health Dept. He also spoke of faulty janitor work there and was advised that he and Mr. King of the Bd. of Education were to handle this matter as they saw best.

Arthur Rysticke, attorney for the Bd. of Education asked about the proposed road going thru the property of the Bd. of Education in the 7th District. He asked if the Commissioners would condemn the land to the rear of that owned by the Bd. of Education, now owned by Mrs Schumaker, and he was informed that the Bd. of Education has power to do this.

Jos. A. Mattingly came in with Wilmer Palmer about taxes Mr. Palmer has paid since 1940, advising that the land is woodland, not tillable, since 1940 and asked for a refund on the taxes he has paid. No decision at this time.

SRC- Jr. Raley came in to discuss usual road matters, and advised that Argyle Court, Oak Court and Barrunger Dr., Town Creek, Capps section, are ready for acceptance by the Commissioners for maintenance.
