Commissioners, their Administrative Asst and attorney were in regular session today

Jr. Raley came to report that all snow shovelling equipment owned by the SRC was out of commission, and asked permission to engage privately owned equipment for this work which was considered an emergency. He was authorized to secure other equipment which he did from Dean and Beavers and Jas. A. Mattingly.

Bob Arnold, Game Warden, asked the Board to approve a Proclamation for "Wildlife Week Mar 20-26th" this was done and copy of the Proclamation sent to the 3 County papers, requesting them to publish same as news item.

Mr. King, with members of the Board of Education, came to talk about Teachers' increment for 1960-61. A long discussion was had. Commissioners agreed to allow as much as possible of the amount requested and Mr. King was advised by phone of their decision.

Lester Mattingly came with several property owners from Long View Beach to ask the County to accept Long View Beach Blvd and Hilltop Drive, Ath D. They were advised the County would accept these roads for maintenance if they are properly built to SRC specifications.

Arthur Briscoe came to talk about advertising in the New York Times. No decision.

Mr. Sterling left to attend a meeting with the attorneys from Charles and Calvert County Commissioners, about the proposed Animal Shelter.
