All officials present today.

Sen. Walter Dorsey came in for a talk on general matters.

Earl Gatton came in regarding the request of Saml. Vallandingham for the bus to come to his place, $1\frac{1}{2}$ mi from highway, and pick up his children. He was advised this could not be done. Children will have to meet bus at highway. Mr. Vallandingham so advised by letter.

Mrs. Clem Johnson, McIntoch Run asked that bus come in to pick up her children. Mr. Alvey will contact Mrs. Guy and see if she can bring these children out to the highway to meet the bus.

Earl Gatton was instructed to go to the Hammett Stone home on Snow Hill Rd $1\frac{1}{2}$ mi from highway and pick up his children. This gives Earl an extension of 6 mi per day. \$216.00 per yr.

Mr. Fred Tilp came in to explain plans and specifications for the new Animal Shelter. Bids on this building will be opened in Charles County Commissioners office Tues. Sept. 13, 4 pm.

Harry Huseman, speaking for a group of parents in his area at Patuxent Beach requested transportation for a number of children to St. John's Paro. School. Geo. Hebb's bus comes within 2 mi of the 7 Gables rd., and he was instructed to go to the 7 Gables road, turn and pick up these children. 8 mi extension 288

Dr. John Griffin, Hughesville, Md., requested transportation for 5 boys from Chas. County to Ryken High school. No decision by the Commissioners at this time. Dr. Griffin will take care of the transportation for several weeks until matter can be arranged. If the Commissioners grant this any additional expense (mileage) will be paid by the parents of the boys. No decision

Mr. Nalley of the Nalley-Davis Rd in Hollywood came to advise that there had been an accident on this road, due to a rise in the road which prevents the driver of one car from seeing the other car. He asked if there was a possibility that this hill could be cut down.

Paul Bell was asked to come in about the Paul Clements child living on St. Andrews Church Rd, & transporting him to Fr. Andrew White school.

Douglas Bond came in about general road matters. Jr. Raley was called at the SRC office and said he would have old wharf and steps pulled away from Forrest Landing and everything ready for the new wharf. Mr. Sterling will prepare ad for bids etc on new wharf.

Mr. Geo. Hebb was instructed to send his bus to Richley Norris' intersection of the roads, turn and pick up Norris and Russell children- about $1\frac{1}{2}$ mi
