

Sept. 27, 1960

All officials present today.

Bernard Drury-Oakville requested bus to stop at entrance to his property to pick up his son. This bus also stops at Quade's entrance closeby. Mr. Hancock asked to have one stop only in this area and Comms. decided if the boy is to meet the bus on #235 he will join the others who meet at Quade's. Mr. Drury said he could take his son to Hardin's Store on #235 and meet the bus there. This would be ok, otherwise bus will stop at Quade's and boy can meet it there.

Sen. Walter Dorsey came in to talk on general matters.

Letter written to Comptroller Goldstein regarding articles he prepared for publication in metropolitan papers. Commissioners advised they agreed with him on subjects under discussion.

SRC Jr. Raley came in when Mrs. Jackson, Abell, 7th D., asked for road leading into her property to be surface treated and complained of large rocks on this road which damaged her car tires. Mr. Raley advised that Traffic Count on that road did not warrant SRC to do this and also that road was not built to SRC specifications. He agreed to check the road and eliminate some of the rocks and put some gravel on it.

SRC group from Upper Marlboro, District Engr. McCarl and Mr. Webb and from Baltimore Messrs Peddicord and Seiber and Sen. Paul Bailey. Messrs Kroh and Korrell representing the T. Edgie Russell Contractors who used the Cora Clarke road and tore it up. They were advised the SRC will need \$500 to surface treat this road. When the contractors first used the Clarke road it had been surface treated, it is now gravelled. In order to surface this road 3/10 mi it will cost \$500, this is to be put up by the contractors. Mr. Korrell will inform his company of the amount the SRC wants and then advise the County Commissioners of their decision in the matter. Should it cost more than \$500 the County will pay the difference, should it cost less than \$500 the difference will be refunded to the contractors. Mr. Korrell will also contact Mr. McCarl advising him of the contracting company's decision.

Bridge at Dillon Creek, also all other bridges in this County. SRC Bridge Engineers will come and talk to the Commissioners about these bridges

Mr. John Briscoe representing Chas. Wood of St. Mary's City came in about the entrance to the Wood property. Mr. McCarl, Sen. Bailey and others of the SRC in Balto will meet and consider what can be done about this matter.

Mr. Jos. Nally of Hollywood asked again about the road, and wanted to know if and when the hill would be lowered etc. as complained of last week. Jr. Raley cannot do anything about this now but will eliminate the hill the end of Oct.

Board adjourned at 3:30 pm to attend the Tri-County Animal Shelter meeting.
