4. Bridge at former farm of J. Frank Bailey near Loveville, to be rebuilt using creosoted lumber to be obtained from SRC, salvaged from other bridges.
5. St. John's manor Rd-need plats- see Wm. Sterling about this
6. All ditches to be kept clean in order to keep water moving.
7. Letter to be sent Mr. Thompson, asking for some of the old bridge creosoted lumber, now at SRC, to be used on Bailey Bridge.
