### RESOLUTION

Upon the Application made by property owners and after full hearing as required by law, be it HEREBY RESOLVED that those lands, as follow, are re-zoned from "C-residential" to "Commercial:"

Situate, lying and being in the 8th Election District of St. Mary's County, Maryland, beginning at a point 200 feet from the southerly intersection of the proposed Franklin D. Roosevelt Blvd. and the Great Mills Road (State Route 246); thence running in a straight line with the said proposed Franklin D. Roosevelt Blvd. in a southerly direction 200 feet and crossing Midway Drive South and Essex Drive South to the presently Commercially zoned area, thus extending the said present Commercial Zone to a depth of 400 feet from Franklin D. Roosevelt Blvd.
