Signs at Library Roads

Wm. M. Loker, Jr., sec. to the Town Commissioners was requested to prepare a sketch of the proposed "one-way" signs needed around the Memorial library.

Elmer Clayton, Mrs. Dunbar and Mrs. Wilstorf of Ridge, requested that the short road between Ridge (R252) and Wynne be treated for dust which is very heavy on this road which leads to Elmer Clayton's Marina. Jr. Raley was authorized to place calcium chloride on same from time to time to keep the dust down.

Vol. Fire Depts & allotment

A delegation from the several County Volunteer Fire Depts., requested information on the amount each Fire Dept. would receive from the 62-63 Budget. \$2,500 has been allowed the 6 Fire Depts., located at Avenue, Ltnn, McKay's Beach, Hollywood, Mech and Ridge. It is agreed that the Commissioners will pay each of the above \$1,500.00 now and retain \$1,000 from each, until the purchase of the Emergency Power Units have been made. Should these units cost less than \$1,000 the difference between their cost and \$1,000.00 will be given to the Fire Depts. Should the units cost over \$1,000 the Commissioners will pay the extra cost. This group consisted of the following:- Lloyd Goddard, B. Kennedy Abell and John T. Mattingly, from Leonardtown, Leslie Hansen and Charles Donaldson, from Lex. Park; John M. Russell, Joe each and Otis Wood from Hollywood; Ed S. Burroughs and John C.
