Roads

Dennis Raley, Jr., of State Roads Commission, was given a letter authorizing him to alleviate the parking problem near the Health Dept. Building. This letter given on 10-10-62.

Mr. Cero, Asst. State Supervisor of Assessment Office, and Mr. Ralph Abell, of St. Mary's County Assessment Office, called in regard to giving the local newspapers publicity re assessments in the County. Mr. Cero prepared a letter to the papers, a copy of same is attached.

School Bus

The Commissioners authorized that a check for \$400 be given to Mr. Sam Bailey, the contractor on the 7th District Parochial School Bus. This amount of money is to be given him for the purchase of a 60-passenger school bus. Mr. Bailey has been using a 48-passenger bus that was overcrowded.
