Dr. Brewster presented the new COVID-19 data dashboard on the Health Department's Website. There have been 1,141 COVID-19 cases in St. Mary's County with 42 deaths. Although the positivity rate for August had gone down, there had been a slight increase in numbers over the last week which were attributed to parties and family gatherings. Following Governor Hogan's Executive Order dated August 2, 2020, Mr. Shepherd consulted with Dr. Brewster concerning the order which addressed face coverings, gatherings, and distancing in youth sports. Mr. Shepherd presented guidelines for Fall Youth Sports that were prepared using July COVID-10 data/metrics and acknowledged the guidelines could be updated once August data is received.
