HEARING - Proposed Ordinance to Repeal and Reenact §§ 50.4.48 and 51.3.48 of Chapter 285 of the Code of St. Mary's County, Maryland to allow a convenience store as a "Permitted" use in the Rural Service Center (RSC) zone.

Notice of Public Hearing was published in *The Enterprise* on August 28, and September 4, 2020.

A public hearing was held to obtain public comment on the proposed ordinance to change convenience stores currently in the Rural Service Center Zone from "Limited" to "Permitted" use. As "Limited" use, a store cannot occupy more than 3,500 square feet on site. If changed to "Permitted" use, the maximum size would be 10,000 square feet, and up to 12,500 square feet with the purchase of 2 transferable development rights (TDRs).

Commissioner President Guy requested Dr. Bridgett to provide the format for the public hearing and opened the hearing for public comment.

Dr. Brewster presented the COVID-19 data dashboard on the Health Department's Website. There have been 1,220 COVID-19 cases in St. Mary's County with 57 deaths. 18% of county residents have been tested. Dr. Brewster advised there is walk-up testing sites in Leonardtown and Lexington Park. There are also pop up testing sites available in the county. She also discussed the Back to School Vaccine Clinics and the importance of the influenza vaccine this year. Mr. Shepherd discussed the guidelines and recommendations for the fall sport season.
