Commissioner President Guy called the meeting of the to order at 2:05 p.m. in the Chesapeake Meeting Room, Governmental Center.

Deputy Transportation Secretary Powell highlighted the funding impact COVID-19 will have on the 6-year Consolidated Transportation Plan. St. Mary's County may see less road maintenance; longer grass with less mowing; impacts to the State's System Preservation Minor Projects Program; unfunded state roadwork; and, evaluation programs to help plan for the future.

Projects specific to St. Mary's included MD 5, Point Lookout Road (reconstruct the MD 5 intersection at Abell Street/Moakley Street; Point Lookout State Park (road widening and sidewalks); New Market Turner Road; and, MD Route 6 repair and replacement.

Other topics of discussion were the Chesapeake Bay Bridge and Harry Nice Middleton Bridge projects; online customer services provided (Customer Connect and First Step); all-electronic and cashless tolls throughout Maryland; reopening of MVA branch offices; Federal REAL-ID deadline extension; and, the MD Route 6 Persimmon Creek Bridge appeal.
